- Must be a current high school senior who will receive a diploma prior to the award announcement (before May 2, 2025);
- Must be a graduating High School Senior;
- Must be accepted to an accredited academic institution (*proof of acceptance will be required*);
- Must be a U.S. Citizen;
- Must have a cumulative 7-semester grade point average of **3.0 or higher**;
- Student must be enrolled full-time for the fall 2025 semester;
- The Scholarships will be awarded to the school on behalf of the recipient;
- Must complete and submit the following by Tuesday, March 11, 2025:
  1. Application Form (please type or print legibly)
  2. 7-Semester High School Transcript
  3. Two Letters of Recommendation
  4. A *type-written* one-page essay (with cover sheet) authored by the applicant
