- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of **3.0 or higher**
- Student must be enrolled full time for the fall 2023 semester.
- The Scholarships will be awarded to the school on behalf of the recipient
 - Must complete and submit the following by Monday, June 16, 2023
 1. An Application Form- Please print and write legibly
 2. School Transcript
 3. Two Letters of Recommendation
 4. A *type-written* one-page essay authored by the applicant
 5. Essay must have a cover sheet
